Particulars of Repairs and Examination. Cylinders & Slide Valve Casing opened and Pistons & Valves examined and overhauled. Condenser tubes drawn and replaced. All pumps pipes & hoses overhauled. Sea cocks & Valves, also Propeller & Stem tube examined in dry dock.

Main Boilers. The rivets in end landings round the bottoms taken out and renewed. New Safety Valves (Eccles Patent) now fitted.

The above repairs have been satisfactorily completed by the London & Glasgow Coy (Limited) and the Machinery & Boilers are now in efficient condition and eligible in my opinion to be noted in the Register Book Lloyd's M.C. 6. 78.
