Particulars of Repairs and Examination Engines have been thoroughly overhauled, Cylinders, Pistons slides & Link motions overhauled. Eccentric straps adjusted. Connecting rod braces & main bearings adjusted. Air, circulating & feed pumps overhauled. Sea connections ground in. Boilers overhauled a few patches and screw stays renewed in combustion chambers. Boilers tested under steam and found tight. Engines worked satisfactorily.  
The machinery & boilers of this vessel are now in good order & safe working condition and render the vessel, in our opinion eligible to remain as classed.
