REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE

S.S. when No 1-78

This vessel's machinery having been under repair, opportunity was taken to effect the following repairs, viz:— All the ceiling lifted off the tanks, the tanks and cement examined, the tank-top cleaned and painted, the tanks tested by means of water, and the ceiling relaid, part being renewed; the cement carried to above the angle iron keelsons at upper turn of bulges; the fore peak scraped and painted, also the tunnel and lazarette; the whole vessel inside above the close ceiling (except in coal bunkers) now scraped and painted; the caul across port of beam lifted, the deck ends recaulked, and the caul refitted; the anchor bolts shifted to this port; some slight repairs effected about decks, and the vessel generally put into good and efficient condition.
