Cylinders & pistons examined. Flaw in Low pressure piston has not extended since last seen. Crank shaft examined found good. Condenser overhauled & tested. pumps overhauled. Stern shaft drawn in & examined found good and replaced. propeller iron refitted and two blades of propeller renewed.

Boilers examined, they have been retubed, scaled & cleaned, and are now in first class condition. Safety valves reground in.

The whole of the machinery is in good order and safe working condition and eligible, in my opinion to have a new machinery certificate granted and Lloyd's M.C. 78 recorded.
