Bottom cleaned & repainted. Rudder pintles bushed. -
It being stated to us that this vessel grounded while on a recent voyage, she has been carefully examined outside & inside and found free from injury.
On port side, about 12ft from stem, near the load waterline, two frames were broken through collision on her last voyage and temporarily repaired at Hingo. This damage has now been permanently repaired by fitting bosom pieces over the broken parts. -
