Limber boards taken up, main hole covers taken off water ballast tanks, all surfaces afford inside & out, scraped down & painted inside & out, cement in flat made good when required. Thirty fathoms of cable chain supplied 1 1/2". Tested at Sunderland to 5 1/4 tons. f. Hartness, Superintendent. Water ballast tanks tested by a head of water to the height of high water mark.
