Damage

Now done four shell plates taken down on the Side, one reset & replaced, & three replaced with new. Rivets renewed in one butt strap. Side seven shell plates taken down in fore body, 6 replaced with new & one refitted. four plates in flat Amidships taken out & replaced with new, three plates taken out in after run & replaced with new. Rivets renewed in twelve butt straps. Two fractured frames new at outer end, inside ballast tanks. Rivets renewed in lower part of Propeller-pool. beams in flat relaid where removed. Bottom cleaned down & coated with paint.
