The vessel placed on blocks in dry dock, the limber boards and several strakes of ceiling on each side removed all fore & aft; cementing of inner surface of bottom plating tested & found sound & adhering satisfactorily to the iron.

Oxidation removed wherever necessary.

Some defective ceiling in hold renewed with pitch pine.

The upper deck at sides inside of poop recaulked.
