Whilst in Garvel Dry Dock, in consequence of the propeller shaft having broken in way of stern post bush. New stern post bush and new propeller shaft fitted, new brass liner shrunk and pinned on and new shaft left 1/4" larger in diam. Sea connections examined and roses cleared. Slight repairs to main boiler.

The engines and boilers being now in good working condition, I am of opinion that the vessel, so far as her machinery is concerned, is eligible to remain as classed.
