Boiler, examined, and twenty three Tubes renewed, eight of which are Stay Tubes, Safety Valves (Spring) scrapped up & readjusted.

The above repairs have been satisfactorily completed by Messrs Lees, Anderson & Co and the Engines and Boiler are now in good working condition and eligible in my opinion to be noted in the Register Book Lloyd's M.C. 14. 79.
