Particulars of Repairs and Examination Through damage said to have been sustained through stress of weather causing the machinery to strain and race violently. A new crank shaft and low pressure piston have been fitted in consequence of flaw in old shaft and piston flange broken.

The machinery and Boilers of this vessel are now in a good and efficient condition and in my opinion entitle the vessel to retain the notification of Lloyd's M.C. (in red) the Boilers and cylinders not having been seen at this time I am unable to recommend the notification of Lloyd's M.C. to be marked from this date.
