REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE

Now done. - Vessel placed in dry dock to clean and paint bottom found the plates very much corroded and pitted all fore & aft from the six feet to the twelve feet water mark, and the rivets in way of same badly pitted & wasted; a large quantity of the rivets in three landings and middle of plates renewed, Hold cleaned and ceiling lifted at the bulges also the cement cut out where rivets renewed, and recemented when required, and ceiling relaid. Bottom coated with two coats of Red Lead Paint and Patent Paint on bottom.

This Vessel's bottom had the appearance as if she had been lying some place where the water must have been impregnated with some matter which corroded and pitted the plates and rivets.
