The Cylinders & Slide Valves & Bearings have been opened and Pistons & Slide Valves examined Crank Shaft with bearings examined also Thrust Shaft & Block, all Pumps, pipes & Fuses, Cocks, Valves & Connections cleaned & examined

The Engines are now in good working Condition and eligible in my opinion to remain as Classed for twelve months from July last, when the Boiler was strengthened & repaired. See Leith Report dated July 10th
