The cylinder covers removed. cylinder pistons and valves examined overhauled and put in good order. Air, Circulating, feed, Bilge pumps and condenser examined and found in good order. Crank shaft opened out examined and found good. Propeller shaft drawn in relined and a new propeller fitted. All the sea cocks and chests ground and overhauled. The boiler doors removed. The boiler examined through-out cleaned sealed and put in good order. Safety valves examined and found good. Donkey Boiler examined overhauled and put in good order. The machinery and Boilers tested under steam and found satisfactory.
