At the present time the Vessel placed on the Pontoon the timbers and ceiling equal to one stroke taken up on both sides exposing both surfaces of plating examined and found good cement tested which was adhering firmly to the Iron and where a little worn has been thickened & mended. Chain cables ranged on deck & examined 240 fathoms. Windlass good new of Greenheart last year. Bottom & coated

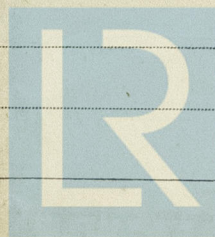
