At the present time this vessel came on the Pontoon to repair Propeller & and to coat her bottom.  
I could only find two Bower Anchors the Captain stating they had lost one and 15 fathoms of chain. I told him when they replaced the same to give me notice which they have not done. I visited the ship on the 3<sup>rd</sup> instant & it was not supplied then and today I cannot find her and think she has sailed.
