REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE

At the present time since Reported by me last month this vessel has had side lights cut in the Sheerstrake on both sides and compensated by doubling plates fitted inside from frame to frame and from the topside plate up to the gunwale stringer plate and rivetted through the Sheerstrake which in my opinion is sufficient
