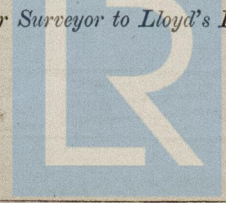
The water tubes in the Combustion chambers renewed as it was found impossible to clean them.
