On the owners application to the committee, it has been sanctioned, that the required ceiling be now taken on board, to be fixed in place after discharge of her present outward cargo, at Mauritius, as per secretary's letter to the owners, dated 19th Decbr. 1879.

This ceiling, 6" x 2" & the bolts for fastening same are now on board. Bottom cleaned & repainted. She is in good condition & eligible in my opinion to remain as classed. H. Paulsen.
