Particulars of Repairs and Examination for S.S. No. 1 Vessel placed on Gridiron, all sea cocks examined, and new propeller fitted. Cylinders pistons and slide examined, new slide fitted to Low pressure piston cylinder. Crank shaft examined and found sound. Air pump examined and found good.

Donkey Boiler examined and found good. new safety valve recommended to be fitted in addition to present one. This, it has been arranged shall be done and notice sent to this office on the vessels arrival in port.

Main Boiler examined, an additional stay fitted to Steam Dome, Boiler scaled & cleaned and cemented at bottom inside with elastic cement. Safety valves examined and found weighted correctly.


The Bottom of Boiler is somewhat corroded outside but not sufficient to be dangerous at present. It is recommended that it be again examined in about six months time to see if the corrosion is increasing.

Subject to the Boiler being resubmitted for survey for this purpose, and the additional safety valve being fitted to Donkey Boiler, I am of opinion that the vessel is eligible to retain her class and to have a new machinery certificate granted.
