Now done. One plate of sheerstrake & one of topside taken out & replaced with new, one of topside & one of sheerstrake taken out & refitted, one plate in flak of bottom new, shock length of gunwale angle new, several rivets in beam knees renewed, Top gallant bulwark repaired, Wood work caulked fore & aft. Bottom cleaned down & coated with paint & black barnish.
