Cylinders & pistons overhauled, slide & cylinder faces examined shafts taken out of the bearings, examined and cleaned, Link motion overhauled, Pumps examined and overhauled. Main Boiler examined and found in good condition.

The machinery of this vessel has been thoroughly overhauled and is now in good condition and in my opinion renders the vessel eligible to have a new machinery certificate granted and Lloyd's Inc. 1.80 recorded.
