Now done. One new plate in the bottom on the Starb side. Two plates straightened and re-riveted, the riveting in the lower edge of Coal Bunker plating renewed. Cement repaired, the ceiling removed for purposes of repair re-laid, and the outside of the Vessel Painted.

The above damage was sustained through grounding at Bilbao, and at Barrow in Furness.
