This ship touched the ground when leaving Cardiff for London, in March last, after having discharged her cargo here, she was placed in dry dock and examined by and all outside & inside as far as practicable, but except a small slightly leaking bottle in flat of bottom and that the paint was chipped somewhat off the bottom, no damage was found. Bottle overhauled and made good, bottom repainted. The ship is now in good condition and ready for service.

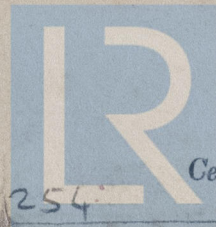
