Cause of Repairs to be clearly stated.

On account of Damage. See New York Report No 137. —  
herewith returned.

Placed on blocks. Bottom cleaned & painted. Some Butts & stoppers  
The Rudder lifted. A plate removed from one side of the same, to  
introduce a length of inner frame which has now been fitted under  
the fracture in the back frame and well riveted there. The removed  
Plate removed, and a doubling plate fitted on the upper end of the Rudder  
on each side. A solid bar introduced across the frame to take the end  
of the plating, and the riveting all made good. Steering Gear refitted.  
Four lengths of Quarter Deck Plank renewed & caulked; and the  
Bulkhead at after part of Boiler Room, renewed with iron.
