Vessel experienced heavy weather while on a voyage from Bilbao to Swansea with a cargo of Iron Ore, and carried away Steam pipe of Winches, Ring bolts, Bridge ladder, basks, Sillings and Mouldings, Iron Stanchions and bulwark from bridge house, Gyps of funnel, rail on the quarter, and sundry small articles lost or destroyed. The hull of the vessel is uninjured. The whole has now been replaced and made good.


