Starboardside 5 new bow plates and 2 doubting plate.

Portside 2 new bow plates, 1 Bow plate taken off made fair and replaced. A few other Stern plates on Portside part rivetted. Stern rivetted up to the top

This vessel when at Anchor off Gravesend was run into by another steamer & had to leave a Power Anchor & some chain which was recovered, and the owner states was put on board on her going down to Gravesend after being repaired here. See his letter attached. Bottom & coated.
