

Extract of Letter of Mr Martell, Sunderland
dated April 28th 1804.

I beg respectfully to state that after
the ship was launched I wrote to Mr Oswald
recommending him to fit side intercostal keelsons
as required by the Committee but this was found
impracticable as the engines and boilers were in the
ship; but Mr Oswald continued the side keelsons
which had already been fitted as far as the engine
room, to the after part of the ship, trusting that under
the circumstances the Committee would regard
this favorably, and consider it sufficient compensation
I respectfully leave the case in the hands of the
Committee."

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
