of the alleged inaccuracy of it as regards  
the number of bidge Kultrons, should be  
received, before the Report is altered; the  
difference being merely one of terms, and if  
it is deemed requisite that the fore and  
aft security at or about the upper part  
of the bidge should be represented therein as  
a "bidge Kultrou", it will be necessary to  
erase it from under the head of "stringer",  
which, as being above the Floor, it is  
considered it may properly be regarded.

As the Committee wish this point  
being clearly indicated, the Report will  
be altered in accordance therewith as  
may be necessary.
