may not be allowed to affect her claims to  
the Character contemplated, and having  
laid the same before the Sub Committee of  
Classification, together with the Surveyor  
endorsement thereon, I am directed to acquaint  
you, that provided, the Rules recommended  
as compensation for the deficiency of the four  
Shakes of plating in the bottom, marked  
in Red on the sketch be fitted, they recommend  
the case to the favorable consideration of the  
Committee
