


DING YARD POINTHOUSE,

We enclose midship section and deck plan shewing the alterations it is proposed to make on the S. S. "Earl King" -

It is intended to construct an awning deck between the present poop and fore-castle, of the same height as the poop, involving an increase of tonnage to the extent of about 270 tons -

The vessel was built on the 1200 ton rule although the tonnage under deck is only 1200.95 - she is therefore of unusual strength for her dimensions -

The awning deck is to be put on for the greater safety and comfort of those on board the ship, and we trust therefore will not injuriously affect the classification -
