We enclose midship section and deck plan shewing the alterations it is proposed to make on the S. S. "Earl King" -

It is intended to construct an awning deck between the present poop and forecastle, of the same height as the poop, involving an increase of tonnage to the extent of about 270 tons -

The vessel was built on the 1200 ton rule although the tonnage under deck is only 1200.95 - she is therefore of unusual strength for her dimensions -

The awning deck is to be put on for the greater safety and comfort of those on board the ship, and we trust therefore will not injuriously affect the classification -
