Dear Sirs

We are disappointed in the Tonnage of our
S. Delaware - We fully expected to be allowed a
portion off the Spar or Awning Deck as in the case
of most vessels, similarly constructed, but as the
deck is complete fore & aft with no opening the
Customs have not yet allowed it. We are still in
hopes of getting a portion of this extra Tonnage
taken off but in order not to detain the vessel
on account of new Register we have not yet raised
the question. We hope your Committee will
not object to the equipment of anchors &
chains -
