the building. Greenock being the
same distance from Belfast as
Liverpool I would feel much obli-
ged to you to appoint a Liverpool
surveyor for this purpose so that
I might be able to be in better
communication with him.

In case there should be anything
found or omitted in the specifications
not agreeing with Lloyd's rules I
beg to say that my contract
contains a clause to the effect:
that all requirements of Lloyd's for
A1 class must be fulfilled in any
case. Would you kindly mention
the amount I have to pay for the
special survey. As I am going out of
