Frames spaced 2" Centre to Centre of angle iron  $3\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2} \times \frac{3}{8}$ .  
Reverse frames to annule every frame.  $2\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2} \times \frac{5}{16}$ .  
Double Bottom for 27 feet amidships.  
Butts of Churn & Strake next below it triple rivetted for 80 amidships.

Proportions  
Over 8 breadths  
and 13 depths in length.
