

Screw Steamer "Hamburg" 370 Tons - Built
at Hamburg in 1871 -

This vessel has been built in accordance
with a Specification forwarded to this Office
by Mr. Pockers, and supplied with Anchors
and Chain Cables of the sizes there shown.

It was not stated that she was to have
a Forecastle, consequently all was considered
correct - it now appears that she has
a Forecastle - 16 Tons in space - this
by the Rules increases the equipment
number from 10339 to 11372 - which
requires the Anchors and Chain Cables
to be one scale in size beyond those supplied,
but, under the circumstances, all being,
apparently, strangers to the Rules, it is submitted
that the vessel is worthy of the Committee's
favorable consideration with a view to
being classed G.O.A. 1. as recommended.

The Committee have relaxed from the
requirements of the Rules in cases
very similar -

Should the Committee grant the relaxation
in this case. Mr. Steenhuis had better be
informed that it is not to be taken as a
precedent -
