Sir

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 19th Instant and to inform you a Screw Steamer designated N^o 18 building by the Barrow Ship Building Company with a view to Classification in the Society's Register Book 90 A is now fitting out, for which boilers have been made from designs from Howard for marine purposes, and which are not of the description commonly known as the Howard boiler, but the arrangement entirely distinct.

I am informed that the boilers have been tested at the Boiler

works during the past week,
with water up to a pressure
of 240 lbs, and subsequent with
steam up to from 125 to 130 lbs
to the square inch. A tracing
of the boilers referred to has been
submitted to the Board of Trade,
and after they have been fitted in
the vessel, a trial of them at
sea is to be made in the presence
of the Surveyors to the Board, before
they will be passed.

I have applied to Mr Robertson
for a tracing of the boilers and
when obtained will send it on to
you.
