The sails are all made and ready to be bent, but for the reasons named in the enclosed letters from the Owners Agent and Messrs Austin & Hunter they are not yet put on board but the vessel is now, in all other respects complete.

The Owners for whom this vessel was built are Messrs W. H. Ross and Co of Liverpool, who are I understand offering her for sale, and it is respectfully submitted that the Certificate may be withheld at this office (if granted) until the sails are put on board to which the Builders consent.

The approved tracing of Mast-caps referred to on the report, was as requested by your letter of the 10<sup>th</sup> ultimo forwarded to London on the 12<sup>th</sup> ultimo and not again returned. will you be good enough to direct that it be attached to the Report.

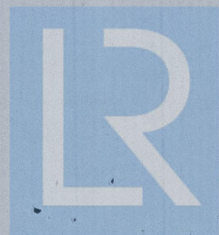
