In reply to your letter of yesterday I must refer you to my former letters on this subject.

I do not want the repairs registered and therefore decline to pay the fees for the same. I feel sure you are influenced by a sense of what you think your duty in the matter at the same time I think your reading of the rules is not correct, and that you are not bound to consider the charge for Registration in making your charge for survey, each item must stand on its own merits. I think the charge £2.2/ for Survey enough

under the circumstances at the same time if you have made it lower in consideration of the fee for Registration being charged and a higher fee for survey is paid by others under like circumstances I am quite prepared to reconsider this charge but must distinctly decline to pay the fee for Registration.
