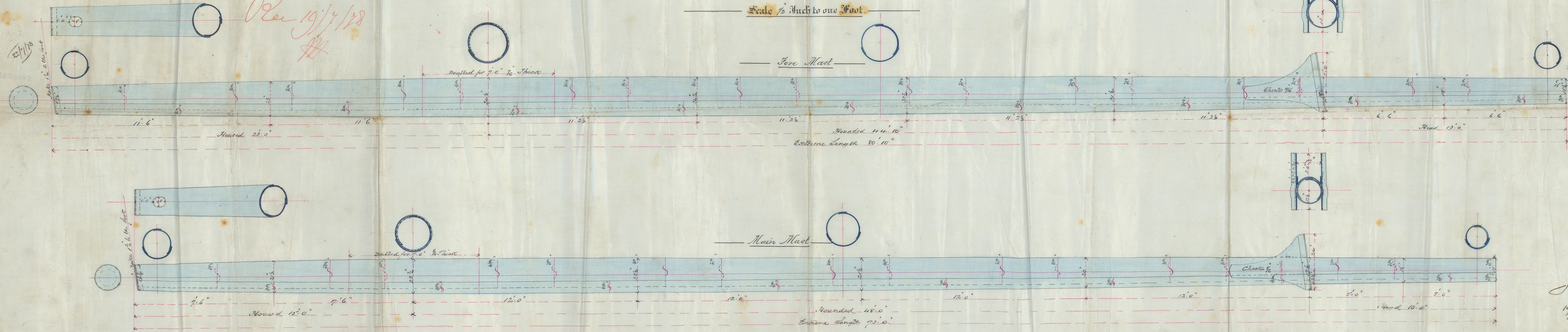
## PLAN OF MASTS

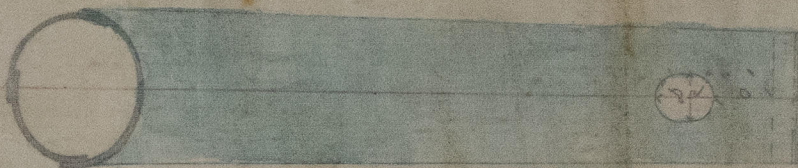
