I am in receipt of your letter of the 30<sup>th</sup> ultimo referring to the case of your steamer "Ella" and beg to acquaint you that in accordance with your request Mr. Morrison, one of the Engineer Surveys to this Society at Chicago has been instructed to proceed to Leith on receiving notice from you of the arrival of this vessel at that port, and make an inspection of her boiler. He has been requested to furnish you with a written memorandum of the recommendations he may make as to the repair of the boiler.
