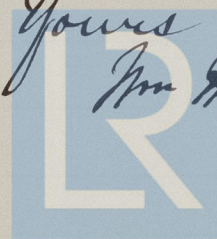

In reference to the conversation which our Mr. Hamilton had with your Mr. Alchin today about the covering of the safety Valves on the boilers; we think it a pity if your Committee will not allow you to pass the Engines & Boilers without this being done. The Owners do not wish the Valves covered

(they being French) and as you are doubtless aware the French Government must have the Valves uncovered so that the Engineer may get at them at any time) & they inform us that if we cover them they will take the covers away as soon as we fit them. In these circumstances we will feel obliged if you will put the case before your Committee & let us know their decision as early as possible, as the Steamer leaves here on Tuesday first.
