Herewith I beg to forward
for the information of the Committee
two letters received from Messrs W.
Hamilton & Co, Port Glasgow, and
Messrs Jas. Menzies & Co, of this port,
relative to the arrangements of the
safety valves of the S.S. "Hermes",
now fitting engines and boilers
at Port Glasgow.
I may mention that two safety
valves, (lever weighted type) each 28
sq. inches area and fitted with easy
gear are attached to each boiler,
but at present to suit the require-
ments of the French law, under
which the vessel is to trade, the
levers and weights are not enclosed.
The workmanship is good and I
consider the valves thoroughly

efficient, but respectfully beg
to submit the whole case, and
await the decision of the Com-
mittee.
