This vessel's machinery and boilers have been constructed in accordance with the requirements of the Society's Rules, except so far as regards the safety valves to the boilers. The Rules require the valves to be cased in so that no extra pressure can be added when steam is up; but according to the French Laws, under which this vessel will trade, the safety valves must all be exposed to view, and the owners therefore request that the Committee may dispense with the strict fulfilment of the Rules in this instance, and assign the vessel the Machinery Certificate to which she is otherwise entitled.

It is respectfully submitted that under the exceptional circumstances of the case the Committee may be pleased to accede to the owners application, but that this case should not be accepted as a precedent.
