Sir

I am in receipt of your letter
of the 6th inst ant, and telegram of this date
relating to the S. S. "Glenroy," Regt. N: 4817
and Messrs J. V. Holmes & Co, and the Owners
have been communicated with. I would add
that on surveying this vessel's equipment
Captain Donaldson informed me that
the Chains and Anchors on board had been
supplied when the vessel was built.

A topgallant forecater was
fitted which I calculated would add
about 40 tons to the Gross Tonnage but
would not affect the equipment.

And on measuring the Cables I feel satisfied
that they were equal to the former Rules
I much regret now, that the first cutting
Report was not obtained from my friend and
