that we the undersigned master Ship Builders
in the Island of Jersey, have been employed
to rebuild the Brig "Robert Watt", and have
done the following repairs to her namely:
After stripping her down below the Bends
and taking out every timber that appeared the
least decayed, we replaced the old with new
viz^t the ceiling, Top Sides, Stern frame, Breasthooks,
Knight heads, upper & lower Deck Beams, Knees,
Decks - Masts &c &c &c. And we further declare
that she is now in as good a state as a new ship.
