Being requested by Messrs Fairbairn & Haugroff & Co.
to state the repairs the Brig Owen had when under
our hands in June 1833. We do hereby certify she
was put into the Graving Dock, stripped and dunnied down,
seven new Floorings, Keelson, Leadwood both forward
and aft, all the Cant Timbers that were defected, Two
Breast Hooks, Nail Bitt and Beam, part of the Deck,
Bowsprit, several planks in the buttock &c, new Ceiling
from the floor head down, all the turnails examined
a number of them renewed, sheathed from the Cappe to
the Bonds, examined and caulked all over and coppered.
Given from under our hands this 23rd
day of October 1834.
