"To hold Beams" - Gibson's patent I plates with wood
bolting lines forward 8 ft - 1 pair diagonal
hanging 2 ft with side arm from 10 to 13 ft
1 pair standing & the staple standards
connected with the Deck Beams

"To Deck Beams" - 8 Staple Standards & 5 diagonal hanging
on each side.

She has also a Hatch.

You will receive here with a Report of Survey on the Ship
"Indian Chief" Messrs Fisher & Son Owners - they did not
make up their minds to have her classed until they had
taken in a considerable portion of Cargo & it was therefore
then too late to put in the additional Iron knees required
