

L'pool Report No. 15283
Extract from letter dated
Quebec 21st May 1858.

"The Brig" Albert "built at Grondines in
1856 was not surveyed while building; from
enquiries I have made about her I understand
she is built chiefly of Tamarac, excepting
her Floors, some of which are of Birch &
those are forward and aft. She was
built for the Lake and Lower Port trade
and not intended to be sent to England
for Classification."
