In compliance with the Committee's request I have marked the height of the inner & outer planking of the Elm on the Reports of the "Ira Lee" & "Ja Lee", which it will be seen is in accordance with the arrangement sanctioned by the Committee in Sept 1863. in reference to vessels of this build & first adopted in the "Zemindar" already clapped.

They are fitted inside with short pieces of plank between the Ribs in the bottom, also batten pieces above placed vertically, and are as well protected for cargo as most Iron Ships.

Except the fittings at the funnels or Waterways they are similar vessels to the "Zemindar"
